AMOUNT: Up to \$1,500

DUE DATE: March 31st

REQUIREMENTS:

Madison County resident who is a high school graduate or holder of GED certificate:

Demonstrate academic achievement

Be highly motivated

Demonstrate financial need

Enrolled as a full time student at a College, University or Trade School for next academic year

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1) Complete an Application

Applications can be found in the MCHS Guidance Office and online at the MCEF website, www.madisonedfoundation.org

2) Submit an essay with the Application

Write an essay on "Why I want to further my education". Essay should be approximately one page (double spaced).

3) Submit two letters of recommendation with the Application –

Two from teachers, or one from a teacher and one from an employer

4) Enclose a copy of the EFC (Expected Family Contribution) from FAFSA with the Application
